



## GOPHERS

1. Lightly "prime" trap with loose soil to conceal cable noose and floor of trap.
2. Find a fresh gopher mound. Dig up and expose open tunnel. In lawns, carefully spade up a rectangular piece of sod and save to cover hole once gopher is caught.
3. Install trap in tunnel opening and seal all cracks with loose soil to ensure no light enters.
4. Keep vent hole clear of soil to allow air to enter.

## RATS

1. Set trap as per gopher instructions.
2. Drop bait through vent hole in rear of trap, keeping bait behind trigger grid. Sprinkle a small amount of bait, use corn, nuts, seeds, grain, bread crumbs, peanut butter, etc.
3. Set the trap in areas where rats are active: under sinks, behind appliances, in storage areas, etc.

## MOLES

1. First determine the direction the moles will be traveling in the tunnel. The mole tunnel network is like a bicycle wheel, the hub or center of the wheel is the nest and the spoke is branching off from the center are the tunnels. Observe the area where the moles have been active. If you observe no movement (which is common) the moles presumably are in the nest. If this is the case, you would set the trap with the trap opening facing the nest.
2. Trap in fresh active runs only.
3. Spade down and clear tunnel.
4. Place the trap in the tunnel. Carefully add loose top soil on floor of trap to conceal cable and plastic.
5. Use suitable cover, cardboard, plastic bucket, etc. Place over the trap to ensure total darkness.
6. Moles are extremely active. If after a few hours you have not caught a mole, move the trap to a new location.

## EASY TO SET!



1. Lay trap on flat surface.
2. With left hand, depress spring flush with top of trap and hold down.
3. With right hand, lay "spring bar" across spring and insert end in "trigger" hold. Gently release.
4. The trap is now set and ready to install in gopher tunnel.

Occasional bending of the spring bar (with pliers) may be necessary to maintain maximum sensitivity.
