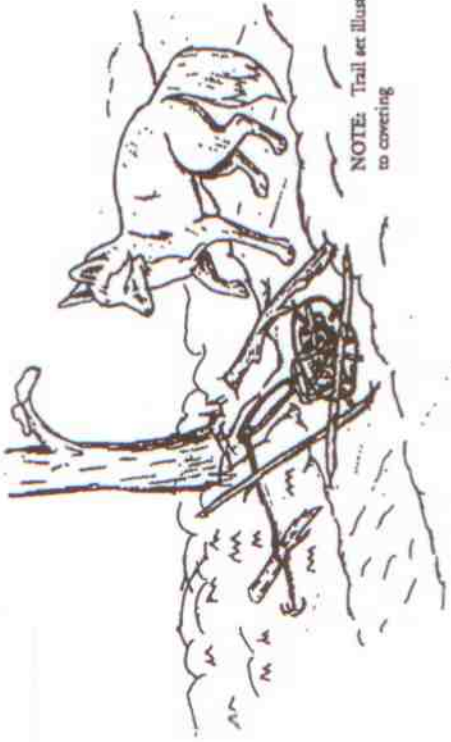

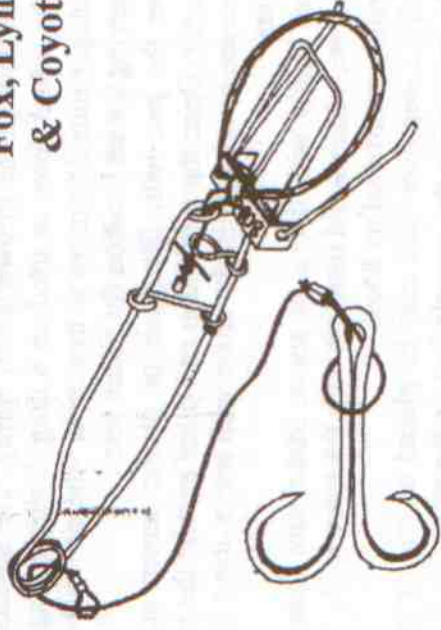

The Fremont Fox Model #809 is designed to cushion lunging by caught animals. The snare lock is designed for minimum foot damage due to its curved shape.

TREATING THE SPRING

The spring and snare assembly can be boiled in logwood dye or liquid trap dye - Andy Stoers Speed Dip or Aarons dye. Do not wax the trap.

SETTING THE FREMONT FOX SNARE THROWER

1. Prepare an elongated trench 4" deep for the spring and 4" deep x 8" in diameter for the pan area.
2. Bring top spring arm down and engage safety clip.

3. Thread snare end with swivel toggle (Figure A) through formed eye on thrower arm (Figure B).
4. Thread swivel toggle through S-hook (Figure C) on lower thrower arm. The toggle must lay parallel to the cable to pass through the S-hook eye.
5. Place the thrower in the prepared trench and anchor to a stake or a drag.
6. The tie down cable supplied has 2 eyes. The fixed eye is looped through the thrower's coil spring. The adjustable eye can be staked down or used on a drag. Using a drag allows the caught animal to move to tree cover where they feel safer, preserving the set location for future sets.
7. Cover the pan with fibreglass or plastic screen cut 9" in diameter. Open the snare loop and place around the pan over the screen cover and lift the snare with sticks about 2" above the pan.
8. Cover lightly with debris or snow. Make sure there are no twigs, etc. which could interfere with the snare loop.
9. Carefully remove safety hook.
10. Finally, a step over stick may be placed on one or two sides of the set to guide the animals foot on the pan.
