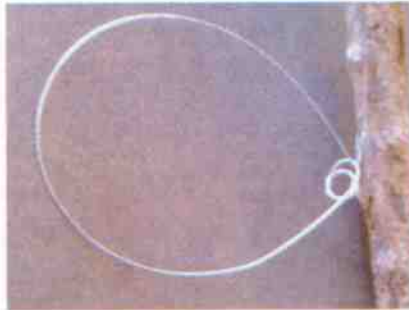


EVERREADY BEAVER SNARE

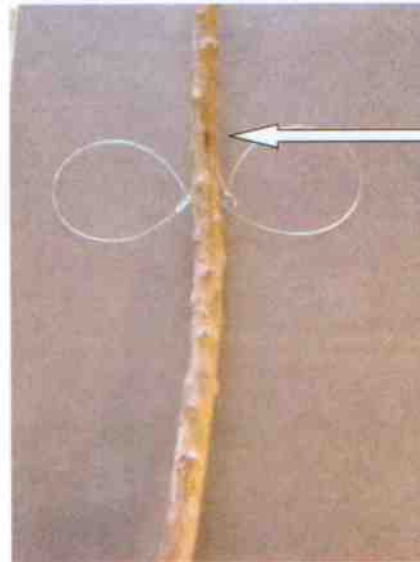

- Nail or wire the loop to a dry pole .
- Bend the snare cable near the loop so when the snare is set, the lock will be at a 10 o'clock or 2 o'clock position.
- If the snare loop gets bumped or partially closed from a muskrat or passing beaver, the loop will automatically reopen to the set position.
- Once the beaver pulls the snare loop tight, it will not reopen.

Place bait (ear of corn, green saplings) here, so when the beaver are swimming around the pole to get the bait they swim through the snares and are caught.

Make sure the bait pole is long enough to stick firmly into the bottom of the pond, stream, etc.
